

2021/22 MI SHOWS Sanctioned Show Guidelines

- 1) All sanctioned shows are required to submit a deposit of \$50 and sanction form to MI SHOWS before December 1, 2021. (Any shows submitting paperwork after 12/1 will only be considered if the dates do not conflict with shows that were submitted by the deadline).
- 2) All shows must be open to all Michigan residents ages 8-21 by January 1, 2022
- 3) All sanctioned shows must offer breed classes for all heifers and steers. If there are less than 3 animals showing in one breed, then the show has the option to let them show in the breed class or move them to the All Other Registered Breed (AORB) class.
- 4) All sanctioned shows must select the top 5 market animals and the top 5 heifers. It is up to the show to decide if they get awards. MI SHOWS needs this information for point totals.
- 5) All sanctioned shows must select the Top 5 or Top 10 overall showman in each age division. Shows more than 150 must select Top 10, shows less than 149 must select top 5. It is up to the show to decide if they get awards.
- 6) A class list with ALL exhibitors and placings for each class along with the champions and top 5 market, top 5 heifers and top 5 or 10 showman in each age group needs to be submitted to MI SHOWS following the shows completion.
- 7) SHOWMANSHIP AGE BREAKS NEED TO BE THE SAME FOR ALL SHOWS – PLEASE USE THESE BREAKS
 - SENIOR – 18-21 as of January 1, 2022
 - INTERMEDIATE – 15-17 as of January 1, 2022
 - JUNIOR – 12-14 as of January 1, 2022
 - BEGINNER – 8-11 as of January 1, 2022
- 8) Educational contests points will only count from 3 MI SHOWS sanctioned shows – Michigan Winter Classic, Michigan Beef Expo and the Michigan Beef Showcase OR Online options will be available.
- 9) The rule that “ALL EXHIBITORS MUST SHOW THEIR OWN ANIMALS FOR MI SHOWS POINTS TO BE COUNTED” must be listed in your show rules and must be enforced.
- 10) ALL SHOW RESULTS (AS GIVEN TO US) WILL BE POSTED ON THE MI SHOWS WEBSITE
- 11) Animals that will be shown by breed and sorted this way for MI SHOW points. Awards will also follow these classifications –
 - Angus Heifer & Steer:** Purebred Angus Registration Papers
 - Char Composite Heifer & Steer:** Charolais Registration Papers & Color Requirements
 - Chi Heifer & Steer:** All registration papers issued by the ACA
 - Hereford Heifer & Steer:** Purebred Hereford Registration Papers
 - Maine Heifer & Steer:** 75%- Maine Registration Papers (Brown)
 - Mainetainer Heifer & Steer:** 25%-74% All Registration papers issued by the Maine Association
 - Shorthorn Heifer & Steer:** 15/16 – Shorthorn Registration Papers
 - Shorthorn Plus Heifer:** Minimum 50% (AR 50)- Shorthorn Plus Registration Papers
 - Shorthorn Plus Steer:** Minimum 25% - Shorthorn Plus Registration Papers
 - Purebred Simmental Heifer & Steer:** 7/8 or greater Simmental Registration Papers
 - Percentage Simmental Heifer & Steer:** Minimum 50% but no greater than 7/8 Simmental Registration Papers
 - ALL OTHER REGISTERED BREEDS – animals with registration papers, but not listed above. Include Limousin (all), Red Angus (all), lower percentage Simmental (less than ½) and lower percentage Shorthorn heifers (less than ½ shorthorn), Charolais (purebred). These breeds may show AORB, animals not meeting these requirements will show as commercial heifers and crossbred steers.
 - Market Heifers** – Show by weight and show with Market animals for Top 5 Market Animals
